Knowledge & Skills

- Children have been learning about music from different time periods, places and cultures. They can speak about how music is founded and the importance of such movements.
- Children are building on their knowledge of improvising, listening, composing and responding. Data shows that children make good progress in their lessons and those with additional needs enjoy accessing the curriculum.

Engagement

- Children were given the opportunity to record their own album in March 2023. They voiced how proud and delighted they were with the outcome.
- At the request of the Children a concert was held in Summer 2023. This involved the community in the local Chapel, and was held to raise money for mosquitoes nets in Mudeka.

Next Steps

- As the curriculum embeds, children are to draw on prior knowledge to makes links between history, music and culture.
- Children will depend their thinking and questioning skills within the subject.
- Use the vocabulary mapping across the curriculum to ensure children are equipped to understand and use technical terminology.
