

## Nursery Provision Offer

All children who are of nursery age are eligible for the universal 15 hour funding offered by the government beginning from the term after their third birthday. In addition, some parents qualify for a further 15 hours of funding through the government enhanced offer equating to 30 hours of funded nursery education in total.

Please note parents of children attending during lunch times are required to purchase a school lunch via our Parentmail system at a cost of £2.58 per meal or provide a home packed lunch.

Parents may apply for additional nursery paid hours. These hours must be in agreement with the Head teacher and will charged at the current additional nursery hour rate of £5.21 per hour. Additional hours will be invoiced in advanced at the beginning of each half term and are due for payment 28 days from receipt of invoice.

The school nursery will supply each nursery child with a break time drink and healthy snack daily free of charge.

Please note the school does not supply any sundry items. Please speak to the Early Years Team should you need to discuss any issues.
